- AO American Overseas The American high school student who will be traveling abroad. Occasionally it will refer to this student after return (see Returnee) to the US.
- Board Member Director of the ATAD Board as defined by the Association for Teen-Age Diplomats, Incorporated By-Laws.
- CSIET Council on Standards for International Educational Travel A council that establishes standards on international educational travel at the high school level, and evaluates conformance to those standards.
- Form DS-2019 US Department of State form which must be completed for International Students from countries where a visa is required for entrance to the United States.
- Guideline General directive or recommendation; job task.
- HF Host Family The American family that has or has had an International Student in their home (see IS).
- INS Immigration and Nationalization Service
- IS International Student Any student who is NOT from the United States.
- ISCOR International Sister Cities of Rochester The volunteer organization composed of the separate committees which maintain relationships with the Rochester Sister Cities.
- Orientation An event to prepare students and/or Host Families for the exchange experience or their return home, in accordance with US Department of State standards and ATAD requirements.
- P & P Policies and Procedures Committee
- Partner City A city with which we have a student exchange.
- Program A city or country with which we choose to have a working relationship with the intent of conducting a student exchange.
- Program Chair A member of the Board of Directors who has the responsibility and authority to run all operations associated with a particular program.

Program Liaison(s) in the Partner City - The person or persons with the responsibility to maintain and coordinate the activities of the American Students and their Host Families while these students are in a Partner City, and the selection and orientation of International Students coming to the US.

Responsibility - Job description of what must be done; clearly expected and specific.

- Returnee An American student who has returned to the US after spending time as an exchange student overseas (see AO).
- RACF Rochester Area Community Foundation.
- SEVIS Student Exchange Visitor Information System The on-line tracking system that supports the Student Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP).
- UNAR United Nations Association of Rochester The local chapter of the United Nations Association of the United States of America (UNA-USA).
- US Department of State The United States governing body for exchange student organizations that issues rules and regulations governing student exchange organizations.
