Dear Overseas Liaison,

The U.S. Department of State and Council on International Educational Travel (CSIET) requires that we administer a test to evaluate the English competency of all international exchange students prior to their acceptance into an exchange student program.

The ATAD test includes 5 parts (listening, grammar, vocabulary, reading, and writing) and requires one hour for your student to take.

Please download the linked files, print them, review them, and then administer the test. When the student is ready to take the oral (listening) portion of the test, open the .mp3 file to play the audio part of the test.

When your student has completed the test, please return the answer sheet to your ATAD Program Chair in Rochester so it may be graded.

All students who will be coming to Rochester are required to take this test <u>prior to final acceptance</u> into ATAD's program.
